• 7 – referee chase boat; ideally, this line represents two boats that can follow a race together

• 8 – referee chase boat; ideally, this line represents two boats that can follow a race together

• 1 – start referee; anchored behind start platforms

• 2 – start marshal/safety; moving as needed

• 3 – mid-course safety; anchored west of Jordan Island, but ready to move anywhere on course to help rowers

• 4 – finish-line safety; anchored south of finish area, but ready to move to warn incoming boat traffic or help rowers

• 5 – docking marshal; moving as needed to manage boats landing or going to hot-dock

• 6 – spare/transport; docked until needed, sometimes moving people over to the finish line judging area
